## TEXT OF THE UFBU CIRCULAR NO.UFBU/2015/48 DATED 18<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2015:

"We had informed the developments since last conciliation meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2015 and the circumstances under which the decisions for putting on hold the four days' strike form 21<sup>st</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> January 2015 and revival of four days' strike from 25<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2015 and indefinite strike from 16<sup>th</sup> March 2015 onwards. We are glad to receive information from all over the Country that the action programmes of UFBU are being implemented in full strength.

Comrades, let us not leave even a single chance to achieve our just demand of reasonable wage revision that too expeditiously. We believe in bilateralism. We believe in negotiated settlement. We are not for any action that would inconvenience the esteemed customers / general public. We also do not have any inclination to provide discomfort to the government. But, the compelling circumstances on account of recalcitrant attitude of IBA pushed the UFBU to the path of agitation. Unfortunately, the flexibility shown by UFBU has not been reciprocated by IBA.

We are extremely glad to inform that trade unions operating in the banking industry have extended their fraternal support and solidarity by calling for Strike in support of our Four days' strike and indefinite strike considering the genuine demands of bank workmen and officers for a reasonable and immediate wage revision along with settlement of other related matters such as Five-day Banking, Regulated working hours for officers, improvements in pension scheme, improvements in other perquisites & allowances, etc.

The details are appended for information of members:

- All India Reserve Bank Employees Association (AIRBEA) and All India Reserve Bank Workers' Federation (AIRBWF) have jointly decided to express solidarity by observing a day's strike on the 25<sup>th</sup> February 2015. AIRBEA and AIRBWF have deplored that bankers' rigidity and Government's silence are the main causes for plunging the sensitive banking sector in prolonged turmoil, creating huge inconvenience to bank customers and enormous loss to national economy.
- ➤ All India Nabard Employees' Association (AINBEA) has decided to fully support the strike call given by UFBU and proposed to extend solidarity support by observing nationwide One Day Strike on the 25<sup>th</sup> February 2015;
