## **RECRUITMENT IN CLERICAL CADRE 2016-2017**

As Members are aware, we have been drawing the attention of the Circle Management to the Manpower trend obtaining in our Branches/Offices vis-a-vis the work pressure mounting on the staff, in the light of the Boston Consultation Group's Manpower assessment. Further to the release of second list recently, our Bank has now come out with the advertisement for recruitment of staff in clerical cadre for the year 2016-2017.

We are glad to inform our Members that around 1626 vacancies have been allotted to our Circle. The recruitment process starts with Phase-I Preliminary Examination to be held on 22, 28 & 29<sup>th</sup> May and 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> June 2016 followed by Phase II Main Examination on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> June 2016.

# **MEMORANDUM OF SETTLEMENT SIGNED ON 07.04.2016**

We inform our Members that Central Bipartite Meeting was held on 07/04/2016 at Mumbai LHO and a Memorandum of Settlement was signed revising the ceiling of reimbursement of petrol quantity, cost of newspaper/magazines, house rent allowance payable on transfer to outside centre and making improvements in provision of uniforms and liveries to sub- staff members. In this connection, we reproduce hereunder the text of the Circular No.25 dated 11.04.2016 issued by Com. M.V.Murali, General Secretary of our dear Federation for the information of our Members.

#### **TEXT OF THE CIRCULAR NO.25 DATED 11<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2016:**

We have been persistently demanding for increase in ceiling of reimbursement of petrol quantity, cost of newspaper/magazines, house rent allowance payable on transfer to outside centre along with our other demands such as improvements in provision of uniforms and liveries to sub-ordinate staff members. We are glad to inform that a Memorandum of Settlement was signed to that effect on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2016 between the Federation and the bank management. The salient features of the agreement are furnished hereunder for the information of our members:

#### A. PROVISION OF UNIFORMS AND LIVERIES:

#### With effect from 01.04.2016,

- All the sub-ordinate staff who are eligible for Bank's uniform will be provided with one additional set of summer uniform every year;
- Sub-ordinate cadre employees posted at Hill stations and eligible for one set of woolen uniform every year and one set of terry cotton uniform once in 3 years shall be supplied with one additional set of terry cotton uniform once in three years;
- All sub-ordinate cadre employees (excluding those who are already eligible for shoes) will be supplied with one pair of shoes every year;
- Maintenance staff in clerical cadre (who are performing same nature of job as they used to perform when they were in sub-ordinate cadre) will be provided with a pair of shoes and uniform as in case of maintenance staff in sub-ordinate cadre. But, the Bank may decide the type of cloth, color etc. of the said uniform;

It was also agreed as under:

- In view of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays of every month are declared as holidays, in terms of 10<sup>th</sup> Bipartite Settlement, the services of maintenance staff on working days in a month may be utilized in such a manner that the additional hours of work should not exceed 15 hours in the particular month;
- Workmen employees posted at Global Marketing Unit, Kolkata shall be exempted from participation in strike action/work stoppage etc.
- A new type of minor penalty i.e "cash penalty upto Rs. 500/-" will be added to the list of minor penalties and will be incorporated w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016 under Para 8 of the industry level Bipartite Settlement dated 10<sup>th</sup> April 2002.
