We thank everyone who has supported our cause in the past year and we look forward to continuing these partnerships and collaborations in the New Year.

In the run up to the new year, it is time again to look back to the year 2016 that is about to pass. The top event at international level was the victory of Donald Trump as President of United States of America and the Brexit vote taking Britain out of the European Union have created a skepticism about "Globalisation and its efficacy" in the minds of the public disillusioned and outraged by the inequalities of an economic system that is tilting more in favour of rich minority while majority feel marginalized and discarded.

The magnificent and majestic 36th General Council which was held on 11th and 12th June 2016 on a grand scale has upheld the organization discipline in an unequivocal terms. Unfortunately, the year also saw heart-rending reports on the devastating "Vardha" cyclone which ransacked the Chennai City and adjoining districts. The recovery is uneven and still very fragile.

Our battle against the privatization and ill motive reforms of the Government continued with a full blown strike on 29/07/2016 as per the call given by United Forum of Bank Unions and we extended our fraternal support to the affiliates of UFBU who participated in the Nation-wide strike call given by the Central Trade Unions.
