## **NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING**

### **TEXT OF NCBE CIRCULAR NO.10 DATED 06.04.2018**

"A Meeting of the National Executive Committee, under the Presidentship Com. Vinil Saxena, President of our organisation, was held on the 7<sup>th</sup> March 2018 at Mumbai.

2. At the request of Com.Sanjeev Bandlish, General Secretary, the House observed Two minutes' silence in memory of Com. P. Lakshmi Narasaiah, former General Secretary of NCBE and doyen of the Bank's trade union movement in the country, who breathed his last on the 9<sup>th</sup> February 2018 after brief illness.

3. Com. Sanjeev Bandlish apprised the house about the latest developments with regard to wage revision. Com. Bandlish informed that IBA had postponed the meeting scheduled for 21<sup>st</sup> February 2018 in view of the disturbed situation in the banking sector on account of the recent PNB fraud and said that the meeting may be held within a month.

4. On the agitational programme of UFBU, Com. Bandlish said that the representatives of UFBU met on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2018 at Chennai and considering the vitiated atmosphere in the entire banking sector in the aftermath of PNB fraud decided not to proceed with the proposed strike on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2018. He also informed about the decisions of UFBU in the said meeting to organise Press Meet in all State Capitals and to hold Dharna before Parliament at New Delhi on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2018.

5. Com. Bandlish informed the house that Com.Vinil Saxena, President has retired from Bank's service on superannuation in the month of December 2017 and submitted his resignation to the post of President and requested the house to decide on the same. Subsequent to acceptance of resignation submitted by Com. Vinil Saxena, the House unanimously co-opted **Com.S.C. Balaji of All Indian Overseas Bank Employees Federation to the position of President of NCBE.**

6. Later, in the interim vacancies that have arisen since the last Meeting, the under-noted co-options to the National Executive and Central Committee positions mentioned thereagainst their names were proposed by the General Secretary and were unanimously approved by the House:

7. Com.S.C.Balaji, President came to the dias and thanked one and all for co-opting him as President of National Confederation of Bank Employees and assured the house that he will work hard towards accomplishment of the goals of NCBE.

Finally, with regard to the queries raised by the members on various issues pending before the IBA viz.Compassionate Appointment, Medical Insurance/Medical Re-imbursement Scheme, Pension Related Issues etc., were replied in detail by the General Secretary and thereafter, the meeting concluded with vote of thanks to the Chair."
