COM. G. RATHINAVEL SUBRAMANI **SUB-STAFF REPRESENTATIVE, CHENNAI NORTH ZONE**



Com. G.RathinavelSubramani, Sub-Staff representative in the Central Committee for Chennai North Zone is relinquishing his position owing to his retirement from our Bank's service on 28th Feb 2022. He has served the Bank and the Union tirelessly for more than 27 years.

Before his appointment as messenger in the Bank in the year 1994 at Arkonam branch, he has worked on temporary basis at Besant Nagar, Aminjikarai, Chetput and Nungambakkam branches. He was transferred to Arumbakkam branch in 1996 and served the Bank from there till his superannuation. Under Career Progression Scheme, he became Senior Head Messenger in June 2018.

Com. Rathinavel started his journey in the Union from the very first day of his entry in the Bank. He has been the frontline warrior of the Union and is known for his fearless attitude. In every given opportunity, he had the courage to voice his opinion and concern for sub-staff in all the forums. No wonder he became a Committee member at Arumbakkam in 2007. In a couple of years he was unanimously elected as the Local Secretary of the branch and held the position for nearly 12 long years.

As a recognition for his unwavering commitment to the cause of the Union, he was brought into the Central committee as Sub-Staff representative for the then Chennai Module in the year 2012. When Chennai Module was bifurcated into Chennai North and Chennai South in 2013 he was made the sub-staff representative for Chennai North Zone.

It is noteworthy to mention that in 2014, Com.Rathinavel displayed his affection towards the Union by using his influence with the local Government authorities to invite the then General Secretary of our Union as the guest of honour for the Republic Day Celebrations at a government school in MMDA colony Chennai in which more than 1000 students participated. He was also instrumental in bringing out commemorative postal stamps during our General Council in 2019 and our Platinum Jubilee celebrations last year.

Com. Rathinavel is a philanthropist. He has not only served the members of our Union but also toiled hard for the welfare of the general public of his residential locality. While he was the President of the Youth Welfare Club of MMDA Colony Chennai, he made strenuous efforts to set up a library and provide a play ground for the benefit of poor students. He has also held the position as a committee member for an Amman temple in his locality and helped in uplifting girl children by extending financial assistance for their education.

In his personal life, he is a contented man. His spouse, Smt.Sakunthala is a home maker. Sri.R.Dhanush, his only son is pursuing his M.B.A at D.G.Vaishnava college Chennai.
