COM. V.LALITHA, VICE-PRESIDENT (HQ), CHENNAI



Com. V.Lalitha, Vice-President (Head Quarters) of our Union is retiring from our Bank's service on 30th November 2023 after serving our Bank for more than 40 years, and consequently she will be laying down her office in our Union.

Com. Lalitha was born in Nellore. Both her parents were teachers by profession. Com. Lalitha worked in Telegraphs Department for a brief period and then joined our Bank as Clerk-Typist on 14th September 1983 at Kovur, Nellore District, Andhra Pradesh. After serving at Kovur for nearly seven years, Com. Lalitha was transferred to Nungambakkam, Chennai under Inter-Circle transfer in February 1990.

Com. Lalitha was an efficient and sincere employee. She had considerable expertise in dealing with Government transactions and also in reconciliation of IOA entries. She was transferred to Thousand Lights branch in August 2002 as Senior Assistant. Com. Lalitha won the "Best Employee" award in 2008 for her job knowledge and strong work ethics.

Com. Lalitha was again transferred to Nungambakkam branch in November 2009 as Special Assistant. She evinced keen interest in Trade Union activities. As an active and dedicated Comrade, she always stood at the forefront when any call was given by our Union. She became the Local Secretary of Nungambakkam branch in 2009.

Lalitha was later Co-opted as Deputy General Secretary (Head Quarters) in December 2015. She encouraged and motivated our young lady Comrades to take up organizational responsibilities.

Com. Lalitha was elected as one of the Directors of SBI Staff Co-operative Society and held the position as its Vice-President. She was co-opted as Vice-President (HQS) of our Union and also nominated for the post of Council member, a prestigious position, in AISBISF in July 2017. Com. Lalitha with a team of 800 lady Comrades took active participation in PINKATHON, a Cancer Awareness Program conducted by the Bank in 2018. She participated twice in UNI-APRO workshop at Chennai. Com. Lalitha deserves all praise for her immense contribution in compilation of the book "Sword and Shield of our Great Edifice" a souvenir released by our Union and also very much involved herself in dealing with the queries of members through our "SBSU VOICE APP".

A fitting farewell was arranged in the Members' Meet of Zone V at A.O. Chennai South Auditorium for Com. V.Lalitha on 19th November 2023 in which the undersigned along with our President Com. V.Sridharan felicitated her.
