Com. T Usha, Deputy General Secretary (Br.) of Coimbatore Sub-office is laying down her office on account of her retirement from our Bank's service on 31.05.2024, after putting in 40 years of unblemished service.

Com. T Usha joined our Bank at Karur Branch in July 1984 and was transferred to Siruthozhil Branch, Karur, in November 1984. She was subsequently transferred to Tiruchirapalli Main Branch in Jan 1987. Com. T Usha always excelled in accomplishing any job entrusted to her and became an expert in handling reconciliation of forex entries.

Her dedication and sincerity were recognized when she was awarded Best Employee among 300 staff members during an Audit at the Tiruchirapalli Main Branch. Also she has been Regional Topper and achieved No.1 position at All India level in Agricultural Gold loan business, earning commendation from our Chairman.

Com. T Usha actively involved herself in union activities from her initial days and was elected as Director of the Staff Co-operative Society at Tiruchirapalli Main Branch.
