### **COM. S.MURALIDHARAN, DEPUTY GENERAL SECRETARY(BR), SUB-OFFICE SALEM**



Com. S.Muralidharan, Dy. General Secretary (Br.), Sub-office Salem is laying down his office due to his impending retirement from the Bank's service. Com. S.Muralidharan joined our Bank on 20<sup>th</sup> May 1985 at Periasevalai. He was inclined to serve the members from his earlier days. He made his entry into Union activities as Local Secretary of the branch. Com Murali was a dedicated staff and performed his duties with utmost devotion and diligence.

In 1989, Com. Murali was transferred to Villupuram, and later, in 2004, to Pondicherry. During that year, the Triennial Conference of beloved Federation (AISBISF) was held at Pondicherry, where Com. Murali, as a young and energetic activist, worked tirelessly and with great discipline for the organization. His dedication and strong organizing skills were remarkable and soon recognized by the leaders.

Com. Murali by his experience, wisdom and commitment, transformed into a confident leader with courage and conviction. He was a loyal soldier of our Organization. He established close contact with the members and was in the forefront always in demonstrations, dharnas, meetings and other trade union activities. In 2010 he was transferred to SME Pondicherry. In April 2012, when a vacancy arose for the position of Asst. General Secretary, Com. Murali was the obvious choice of the leadership and was inducted into the Central Committee.

Com. Murali believed that good leadership comes from a mix of clear thinking and open communication. He felt a leader should set a clear vision, inspire youngsters, make transparent decisions, and lead by example. He was a selfless guide who motivated and guided young members to work with care, dedication, and sincerity. He always insisted that all members should stand united under the union's banner whenever there was a trade union call.

In 2015, he was transferred back to Pondicherry Branch. Com. Murali was an efficient Defense Representative who successfully defended many employees and helped them overcome difficult situations. He was also a skilled negotiator who effectively handled members' issues with the management. In August 2019, in recognition of his seniority and unwavering loyalty, he was unanimously chosen as the Convenor of UFBU Pondicherry and the General Secretary of Pondicherry State NCBE. In 2020, he was nominated as a Council member of AISBISF.

Com. Murali always emphasized that our union's main role is to protect the interests of its members and that leaders should set an example by empowering them. In 2021, he was elevated as Deputy General Secretary (Br.) of the Sub-office, Salem.

In his domestic front, Com. Murali is much contended. His wife is a home maker. They are blessed with the two daughters who are doctors. Elder daughter is an Orthodontist and younger daughter is an Ophthalmologist.

A grand felicitation function was organized for Com. Murali, along with the Members Meet of Zone 24 and 25 at Hotel Sunway Manor, Pondicherry on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2025. The valuable presence of Com. L.Chandrasekhar, General Secretary of AISBISF & NCBE and Com. Pankaj Kaushik, President, AISBISF along with the undersigned, President, Office bearers and Veterans enhanced the significance of the event. The leaders were all praise for Com. Murali for his valuable services and unwavering commitment towards the Organisation.
