### **COM.S.NAGARAJAN** **DY.GENERAL SECRETARY, CHENNAI SUB-OFFICE**



Com. S.Nagarajan, Deputy General Secretary of our Chennai Sub-Office is laying down his office owing to his retirement from Bank's Service on 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2013. The name of Com. Nagarajan evokes one of the eminent personalities in the annal of our great edifice whose enlightened mind had the courage to denounce the wrongs whenever and wherever perpetrated by the exploiters.

Com.Nagarajan was graduated from New College, Chennai and displayed his inclination and conviction to serve for the cause of others even during his college days as Assistant Secretary of the Students' Union. He was appointed in our Bank on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 1979 at Bodinayakanur where he commenced his journey on the path of trade union as the Unit Committee Member.

In 1981, he was transferred to Zonal Office, Chennai where he had the opportunity to co-ordinate with like-minded comrades and devote more time for trade union activities. It was in 1994, he became the General Council Member and was elected as Unit Secretary of Zonal Office in 1999.

Fundamental values of a trade union is independent and superior and have to be judged in a spirit of utmost faith setting aside personal preferences. Com.Nagarajan had made the organization's values as his life's dearest ideal and ensured that the interest of the organization is fully protected. He courageously held our union's torch aloft letting its searching rays fall upon all and exposed the inimical forces of our organization. During the times when our Union launched agitations against the Management and organised demonstrations, the call of the union was meticulously followed and Com.Nagarajan was in the forefront as the Unit Secretary of Zonal Office Chennai, to implement successfully the agitation programmes.

In 2003, he was inducted into our Central Committee as the Assistant General Secretary of Zone-XXII. Our Union hosted the All India Conference of our Federation in 2004 at Pondicherry. Com.Nagarajan camped at the Chennai Central/Egmore Railway Station for about 3 days to welcome the leaders/delegates from all over the country and made all arrangements for their onward journey to Pondicherry which speak of his commitment/involvement in the organizational events. The originality of his ideas, his eloquence and untiring zeal received appreciations and enhanced his reputation.

Consequently, he was elevated to the position of Organizing Secretary of Chennai Sub-Office in 2006. During this period, he availed every opportunity to devote his time and energy for the organizational work and his efforts left deep traces everywhere. Whenever the Federation leaders/leaders of the affiliates paid visit to Chennai, he was entrusted the responsibility of receiving & accompanying them. He, thus, came into contact with several leaders and became dear to all of them.

In 2009, he was elevated to the position of Dy.General Secretary, Chennai Sub-Office and was nominated as Federation Council Member in the year 2012. He aroused the torpid and nerved the timid and attacked with equal vehemence and vigour whenever injustice is perpetrated upon our members.

John F.Kennedy once said, "Let us think of education as the means of developing our greatest abilities, because in each of us there is a private hope and dream which, fulfilled, can be translated into benefit for everyone and greater strength for our nation". Having regard to the importance of the education, Com.Nagarajan has undertaken the noble cause to provide education to 10 poor children every year. It is not possible to change the whole world all at once. We have to begin in small groups and that is what Com.Nagarajan has been doing as his humble contribution to the society.

It would not be an exaggeration to say that Com.Nagarajan's life is a mission. He is ably assisted by his wife Mrs.Shriranjini who is also working in our Bank as Special Assistant at LCPC, Chennai. They are the ideal couple, doing their best for the people around them and generate goodwill wherever they be.

On the eve of his retirement, we express our gratitude to Com.Nagarajan, a thinker and humanitarian who has done his best for the organization as a whole. We wish him a hale, healthy and active retired life.
