I am proud to say that , I am being the member of SBSU that was formed & guided by bright minds like you.


There were mixed of Emotions echoing my mind knowing how your single command used to be the mantra for the whole chennai circle.

STOPPAGE OF FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS ON THE BASIS OF E-MAILS IN NON-NRI CUSTOMERS

Please refer to e-circular No. NBG/PBBU/NRI-GEN/6/2013-14 dated 19th December 2013 wherein it was advised that the branches should not carry out any financial transactions requested by the NRI customers through e-mail even if the request is made by a letter scanned as an attachment.

- 2. Since possibilities of frauds using similar modus operandi in the accounts of **Non-NRI customers** cannot be ruled out, it has been decided by the Competent Authority that the branches should not carry out any financial transactions requested by the **Non-NRI customers**, **too**, through e-mail even if the request is made by a letter scanned as an attachment.
- Any violation of this instruction will be viewed seriously.

SOP FOR OPERATING CDM ON HOLIDAYS

We refer to your representation seeking the SOP for operating CDM on holidays.

2. In this connection, we advise that Anytime Channel department, LHO Chennai has communicated the following clarification to all the modules vide their letter DGMAC/2022-23/1 dated 01.04.2022, with reference to the earlier SOP dated 15.09.2021 (enclosed).

"(a) Both the custodians of the identified branches will attend office on holidays and declare the day as Working day in CBS as per screen shot enclosed. Then take cash from vault and do necessary posting in CBS as done on other days and load cash in the identified ATMs. In respect of ADWM the cash will be evacuated wherever necessary and do necessary posting in CBS as done on other days.

(b) The identified branches will assess the cash requirement for the holiday loading and if necessary, will arrange for cash from the linked CAC/ Currency Chest branch and keep it in Branch Cash balance of the branch.

In the above circumstances, the situation of taking cash on previous day and loading on the next day does not arise."

WATCH YOUR HEALTH

VITAMIN D

According to the recent data nearly 76% of the Indian population suffers from vitamin D deficiency. Vitamin D or the sunshine vitamin is a vital nutrient that helps to regulate the amount of calcium and phosphate in the body. This in turn promotes stronger bones, teeth and muscles.

Since, vitamin D is a potent modulator of immune system, its deficiency leads to autoimmune disorder such as rheumatoid arthritis, cardiovascular disease, cancers, depression, suicidal tendencies, obesity, and diabetes, infections such as tuberculosis, influenza and increased risk of fractures due to osteomalacia. In children, it causes rickets, osteomalacia and skeletal deformity.

Changing food habits and an indoor lifestyle with inadequate exposure to sunlight have led to a drastic increase in cases of vitamin D deficiency. Experts suggest having enough exposure to sunlight and consuming foods rich in vitamin D such as egg yolk, oily fish, red meat and fortified

foods. Vegetable and grains are poor sources of vitamin D. If vitamin D deficiency is diagnosed it can be treated with medications. Prevention is better than cure. So, get your vitamin D tested to prevent many diseases.
